

It is time, once again, for the Lake County Summer Youth Employment Program. This popular program, funded by Lake County, will provide meaningful work experiences for approximately 150 youth this summer. There is a simple paper application that must be completed. We no longer accept phone applications. These applications will be available on February 1, either on line: www.lakecountyjobcenter.com , at local township offices, at many local schools, and of course at the Waukegan Job Center, 1 N Genesee Street, Waukegan. They will be available on Wednesday, February 1, 2012.

We will begin accepting applications on Wednesday, February 1, 2012. We will accept applications until Wednesday, February 29, at 5:00 pm. Applications will be accepted in person at the Waukegan Job Center, by mail, and by fax: 847-377-3474. Mailed applications must be postmarked no later than Wednesday, February 29 in order to be considered. We can not be responsible for lost or misdirected mail. Only one application, per person, will be accepted. Applications will be randomly selected by a computer program.

To qualify for employment, youth must be between the ages of 14 & 18, in school and meet low income guidelines. Youth ages 14 thru 22 with an Individualized Education Plan (IEP) , in school, could also be eligible. You must be born by April 15, 1998 to be considered for this program.
